Safety Tips for Children

I know my full name, address including zip code, phone number including area code.

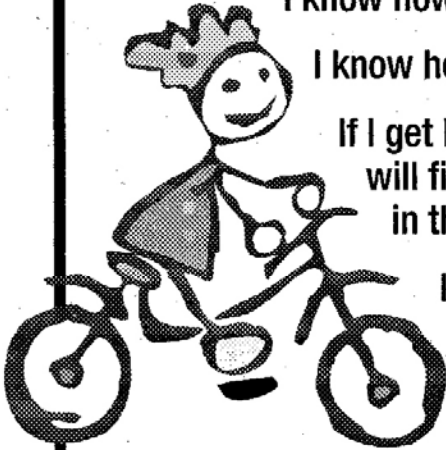
I know how to use a pay phone.

I know how to dial 911.

If I get lost in a store and I can't find my Mom or Dad I will find a clerk or cashier, or someone who works in the store for help.

I never go anywhere alone.

I always check first with my parents before I go anywhere. I always check in regularly with my parents when I am not with them.



If anyone bothers me while going to/from school I get away from that person and tell a parent or teacher right away. A grown up should never ask a child for directions-they should ask other grown ups.

If a grown up asks for directions I always tell them to ask another grown up.

I never take shortcuts from school or friends houses – I always follow the route that my parents know.

I never accept a ride from anyone, even someone I know – unless my parents have given me permission.

Grown ups should never ask kids to help them look for something like a lost puppy or kitten.

Grown ups should never ask kids for directions.

If someone tries to take me somewhere, I get away quickly and yell – “This person is trying to take me away – or this is not my Mother/Father.”
